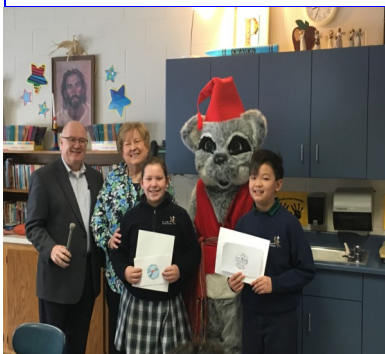
Enrollment 2018-2019
